If you're using your own router/firewall, and want to route traffic directly through the modem/gateway instead of having it NAT your traffic, you'll need to enable bridge mode.

Use the router settings to disable your Wi-Fi name (SSID) broadcasting capability. This could be in the SSID Broadcast-type section or an Access Restrictions area depending on your router type.
