For metal boxes, press down on the Box Doctor® clip and then use your fingers or a screwdriver to slide the clip to the right or left locking the clip onto the damaged box.

Once the box is in the wall, you tighten the screw, and the clips wedge themselves between the box and the inside of the wall. You can also buy electrical switch boxes with built-in switch box support clips.

With the Box Doctor, there's no need to replace the broken box, just apply the Box Doctor for an easy fix! Simply attach the Box Doctor clip to the broken wall box and screw the outlet into the new 6-32 thread slot.
