In 2021, the majority of Iraq's electricity consumption was attributed to the residential sector, which used 65.0% of the total. This was followed by the commercial and public services sector at 21.6%, and ...

The electricity sector in Iraq is almost entirely dependent on fossil fuels, which accounted for about 99% of electricity generation in 2023. As can be seen from the graph above, energy ...

Reliable power supply has been elusive for over three decades, with shortfalls beginning in the wake of the first Gulf War in 1991. Electricity shortages remain widespread despite significant government ...

Approximately 87% of the population had access to electricity. A combination of wars, sanctions, looting and vandalism has however, severely affected the entire power system infrastructure in Iraq. During ...
