

Manual pull-out tool for optical module dust plug

SFP transceivers allow for the transmission and reception of optical signals in networking devices such as switches, routers, and media converters. In this guide, we will walk you through the ...

Pull out the optical module in the horizontal direction (please use even force when pulling out to avoid damaging the handle), and cover the optical module slot with a dust-proof cap.

Disconnect the optical cable. Gently pull the module latch or release ring, depending on the module design. Remove the module in a straight motion - do not twist or pull at an angle. ...

Once the latch is released, hold the module by its metal casing and gently pull it out of the slot. Avoid using excessive force, as this could damage both the module and the device.

Rotate the handle of the optical module down, gently push the optical module, and then pull out the optical module by the handle, as shown in Figure 1-115. When installing a CFP optical module, hold ...

Press the optical cable connector latch down, and gently pull out the optical cable. Tip - Fully remove the cables from the transceivers. Optical equipment is ...

For this SFP, you can push on the front of the mechanism with a narrow tool to disengage the locking leg and pull the SFP out. Here is a 25G SFP latching mechanism. You can use a thin ...
