This book offers a fresh historical analysis of Nordic relations to Israel during the decades following its establishment in 1948.

Ten tribes in the north, called the House of Israel, with Samaria as their capital and the other two tribes in the south, called the House of Judah, having Jerusalem as their headquarters.

When the 10 tribes of Israel were deported, the tribes of Dan and Asher - and probably also Naphtali, and maybe Gad as well - became known as the Aser and Vaner of Nordic history.
