



## What color is the normally open indicator on the distribution box

The color indicator in the handle indicates whether power on that circuit is ON or OFF; if the status is green, power is ON, if it is white, power is OFF, and if it is red, the breaker tripped.

Green is typically open, Red is typically closed. Way back when Green was closed and red was open.
