



# Where to plug the optical module into the switch

A module must be in the uplink slot at all times. Do not remove the dust plugs from the pluggable transceivers or the rubber caps from the fiber-optic ...

Holding the SFP module by its sides, insert the SFP module into the port on the switch. Slide the SFP module into the port until you hear it click. If the SFP module has a handle, push up on the handle to ...

To extend the service life of the optical transceiver and prevent link failure, it is essential to follow the proper SFP installation and removal procedures as outlined in the tutorials above.

SFP transceivers allow for the transmission and reception of optical signals in networking devices such as switches, routers, and media converters. In this guide, we will walk you through the ...

Carefully slide the SFP module straight into the port slot. Apply firm, even pressure directly along the horizontal axis. Do not rock, twist, or force the module. If significant resistance is felt, stop, ...

Ensure that the optical module is correctly oriented and gently push it into the optical port until you hear a click. If the optical module cannot be completely inserted into the optical port, do not force it into the ...

Verifying that the cage notch and hinge are along the same edge, insert the module into the cage until the module latches into place. The module is fully seated when you hear a click.

Insert the Module: Gently push the module into the slot until it clicks into place. Avoid using excessive force; the module should fit securely but should not require force. Once the SFP ...

Pull out the optical module in the horizontal direction (please use even force when pulling out to avoid damaging the handle), and cover the optical module slot with a dust-proof cap.
